We have spent the last two decades devoting our lives to this community and providing a safe, nurturing environment for children to train in the art of dance. Today, 20 years later, we reflect feeling humble yet still driven to maintain an atmosphere that fosters creativity, encourages self-discipline and healthy lifestyle habits all while keeping high standards of excellence in the art and technique of a well-rounded dance education.

We laugh now when we think of ourselves as young women carrying two by fours across Jog and Lantana Road from Home Depot because we couldn't afford to rent a truck. Laying those floors and painting those walls ourselves now proves to be a symbol of empowerment. If we could do those things at 24 and 28 years old... we could do anything!

It was our parents that afforded us the opportunity to achieve this dream. Our late father Don and mother Angela believed that we could, and financed the initial purchase of a small business in a 1,200-square foot rental space. Lantana Square was not a full strip mall in 1998. In fact, we were one of only a half a dozen businesses in the plaza. Mom and Dad encouraged us to stay focused and enthusiastic when we taught classes of 2 or 3 students when enrollment was 28 that first summer. After year one, we enrolled over 100 students and we could hire on additional faculty. As our enrollment continued to grow, in year 3 we expanded to 2 bays. By year 5, we were turning students away from full classes because we had grown to capacity. In 2003, we expanded to the 10,000-square foot facility that we still call home today!

All our success would have never been possible without a stellar faculty and staff. Through the years, we have welcomed so many beautifully talented and hardworking individuals. Faculty members that feel more like family at this point. Thank you to Jessica Pearl, Nicole Smith, Larry Albright, Katherine Lameyer Beukers, Loren Foster, Viky Smith, Kameron Bink, Ben Slayen, Megan Dunn, Brittany Spradling and Marissa Martinez for your dedication and talent. Along with Linda Marzlak and Barbara Brooks, this dream team makes us look good and our students shine.

Hard work and dedication coupled with the love and support from our family has been the secret to our successes. This community has encouraged us and pushed us to work harder and be better and we are eternally grateful. Thank you for your trust and support over the past 2 decades. Time moves fast but time well spent is a blessing. It feels fantastic to have history and even more amazing to know that we have impacted so many children in this community to feel empowered . . . and all it took was some heavy labor and a will to never give up back in 1998! The past 20 years have certainly been "The Greatest Show" and we know you will feel it when you experience the 20th Annual Gala today!

Congratulations to all our dancers. Your hard work gets rewarded today! May you always be empowered to reach for your dreams and never give up! Merde!

Artistic Directors



Andrea LaMaina received her BFA in Dance Performance and Education from Towson University in Maryland. Mrs. LaMaina is the past President of DMA, Florida Chapter 2. She holds a National Teacher Education Certification as well as a Teacher Certification in Dance/Vocational Arts. She is an active member of Dance Educators of America and Dance Masters of America. She is the President of "The Young Dancer Foundation of South Florida, Inc." a non-profit 501(c) (3) organization that accepts charitable, tax deductible donations to benefit talented young dancers. Andrea is the Founder of the So Flo Tap Festival, and produces an annual event to promote the American art form of tap dancing, tap jamming and improvisation. Andrea is the teacher and choreographer of many title holders on a regional and national level. Her students have earned many scholarships to prestigious summer intensives and higher education dance degree programs. Her choreography has earned many awards throughout the years and Andrea is sought after as a judge on several competition circuits. She enjoys teaching master classes both locally and regionally and sharing her love of dance with eager dancers. Before college, Andrea trained under master teacher Fred Knecht. Andrea has choreographed for the Wellington High School Dance Team from Wellington, Florida, who was invited to perform at the Orange Bowl Classic's half time show. Before becoming co-owner and Artistic Director of That's Dancing, she was a faculty member at Glen Rock Middle School where she designed and created an exploratory arts curriculum, which included dance and creative movement. In 1997, she was nominated for The Sallie Mae Best New Teacher of the Year Award, a national honor recognizing her achievements in innovative curriculum development and design for public education. Andrea has also danced professionally with DDM Company based in Fairlawn, New Jersey. She is an active member of the National Dance Association and the Florida Dance Association. In 1994, she was chosen to perform with renowned choreographer Maureen Flemming in an original work at the Stephen's Hall Theater in Baltimore. In 1990, Andrea was a scholarship recipient for the Alvin Ailey Summer Dance Program. For several years, Andrea was a performer and featured dancer in various roles at the Bucks County Playhouse in Pennsylvania.

Michele Walsh holds a Master of Education in Dance from Temple University and a Bachelor of Arts in Theater from the University of Miami. She is the past Vice-President of Dance Masters of America Florida Chapter 2. She is a certified teacher with the Dance Masters of America Organization and Dance Educators of America.
